SCHOOLS

The Scheme is able to support schools and teachers in the delivery of curriculum subjects using sport and Football as the vehicle of delivery, such as History (History of Lewes FC), PHSE, Numeracy & Literacy. Each course can be tailored to your specific requirements and the requirements of the National Curriculum and can be delivered during school hours or within an Extended Schools programme.

Work within local schools continues to develop and increase and as well as teaching football skills, the Scheme has created new initiatives that focus on social skills and working together.



This has been highlighted in the Fair Play Scheme that teaches children during school lunchtimes to develop specific skills to ensure that when they play together there is no bullying, cheating or arguments. All participants are rewarded with certificates and this scheme has so far proved very popular with pupils, staff and parents alike.

KICK START

Another project, in partnership with East Sussex County Council's Reintegration and Behaviour Support Service, allows young people who may find school a particular challenge to attend and learn about sport, health and exercise.

The Kick Start project attracts young people from all over the county and has been so successful that plans for the Community & Education Scheme to achieve accreditation to deliver nationally recognised qualifications are at an advanced stage. This will enable those who attend community projects delivered by the Scheme to achieve nationally recognised qualifications themselves.

COACHING

Football coaching sessions and holiday courses have proven to be particularly popular throughout the past year, and the number of children attending and actively participating has continued to increase. Aimed at increasing grassroots participation in football, sessions for both boys and girls aged between 5 and 13 have a particular emphasis on fun and enjoyment.

They are delivered by our FA qualified and CRB checked coaches and usually begin with fun games and warm-up drills, followed by some skill and technique development, with a short match to finish.
